Club Ebony, one of the South's most important African American nightclubs, was built just after the end of World War II by Indianola entrepreneur Johnny Jones (1907-1950). Under Jones and successive owners, the club showcased Ray Charles, Court Spane, B. B. Bobby Bland, Little Milton, Albert King, Willie Clayton, and many other legendary. When Johnny Jones died, his son, Johnny Shepard, inherited the club. In 1971, the Mississippi Blues Commission purchased the club and renamed it Club Ebony.
